MEETING MINUTES

- Call to order

 - Minutes reviewed by Bridget Edge, no comments or adjustments

- Schoolwide Data/Testing: STAR, Dibels Literacy scores reviewed. Winter Dibels data: As a school 422 students tested and 60% are at or above or receiving core support. From fall testing, winter scores show a trend in the right direction as we have decreased intervention/urgent and increased at or above/core support.
 - STAR math data shows 362 students were assessed and of that 75% were at or above/core support. From fall testing, winter scores show a significant increase of 30% in the at or above section.

- Schoolwide we have been working on revamping our MTSS, each week Mr. Okeke (the principal) meets with a different grade level and focuses on students that are in need. Each grade has three teachers and a paraeducator, and they identify students who need additional support. Those students then get specific interventions for six weeks. The team uses progress monitoring to see how the interventions worked and what steps to take next. The overall feeling is that it is working great and is helping many students.

- Caring School Community is very beneficial helping to connect how subjects (i.e. Perseverance) tie together at home and at school. Every week the kids get a different partner, giving them an opportunity to meet and get to know other classmates. Overall a favorable opinion of the implementation and looking forward to a full year next year.
