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MEETING MINUTES

- Call to order
- No public comments and no meeting minutes to review as this is the first meeting
- Role of the site council ; academics, how are we doing, how are we engaging, belonging and equity, are we being inclusive. Teachers are working with students on open discussions about their identities.
- Discussed what the site council is not. This is for academic, curriculum and SEL.
- Assigned roles for secretary (Scarlet Ekrem) Time keeper..
- Reading; 35% of our students are at above grade level or on watch. 46% are at intervention/urgent
With math we have 66.5% are at or above or on watch and only 33% are on intervention/urgent. Only 360 students were tested on math compared with 413 tested for reading.

- School enrollment numbers are at 435 currently.
- 121 kids absent today due to sickness and late start
- School improvement plan- two main goals are to create a comprehensive schoolwide MTSS structure and focusing on the interventions that we provide to help students, identify students in need, monitor their progress and meet to evaluate if the interventions are working. (restructuring the MTSS strategy)
- Second goal is to implement the caring school communities curriculum. In January of 2023 staff will be trained on the curriculum. to help students regulate themselves, their emotions, their behaviors and positivity.
